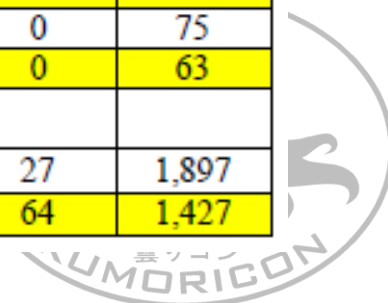

- And everyone else who helped us this year!



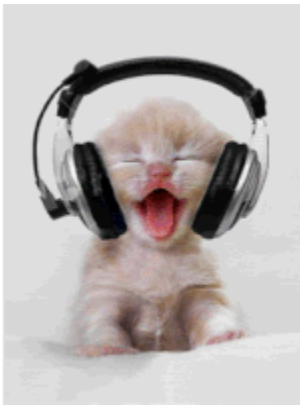

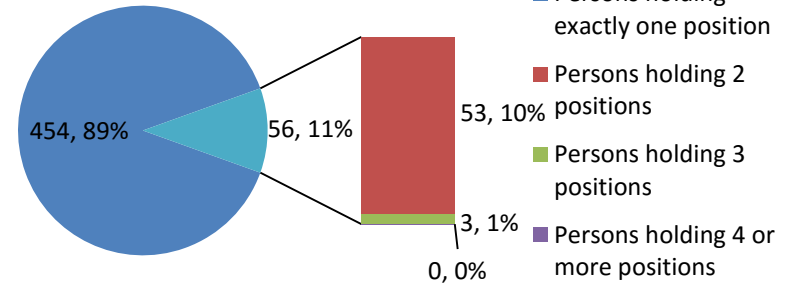
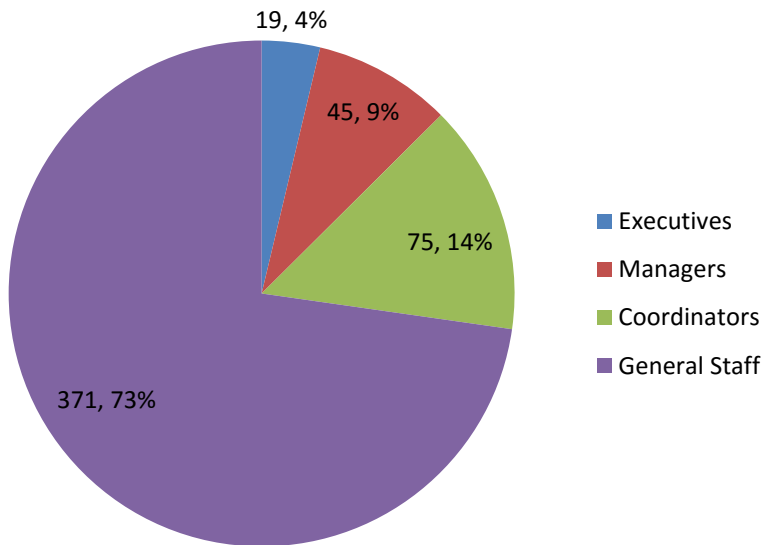

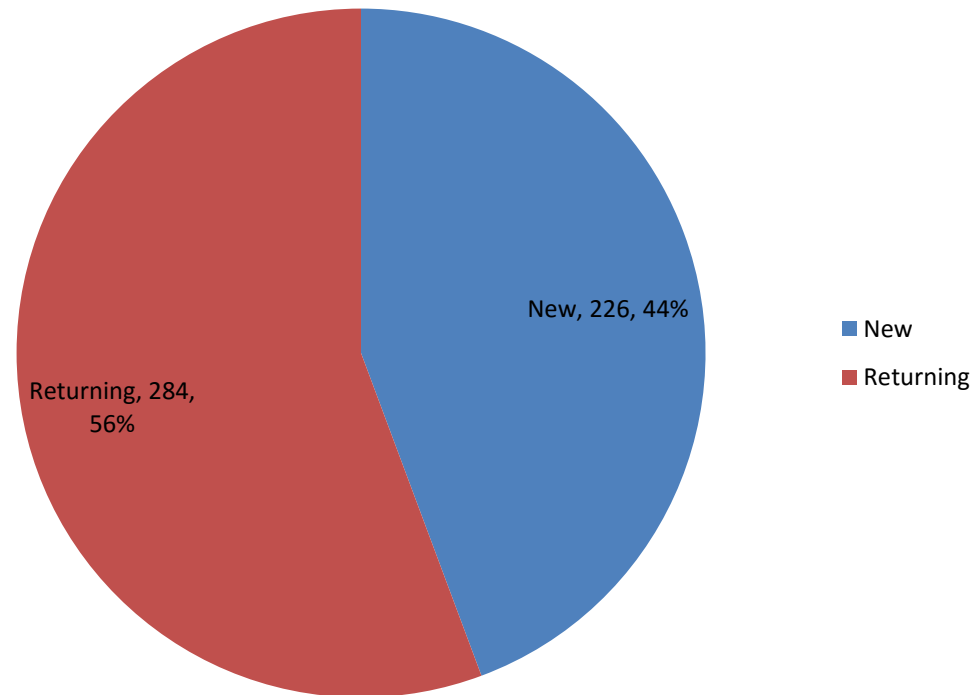
Position Distribution

Most people held only one position, but some held more

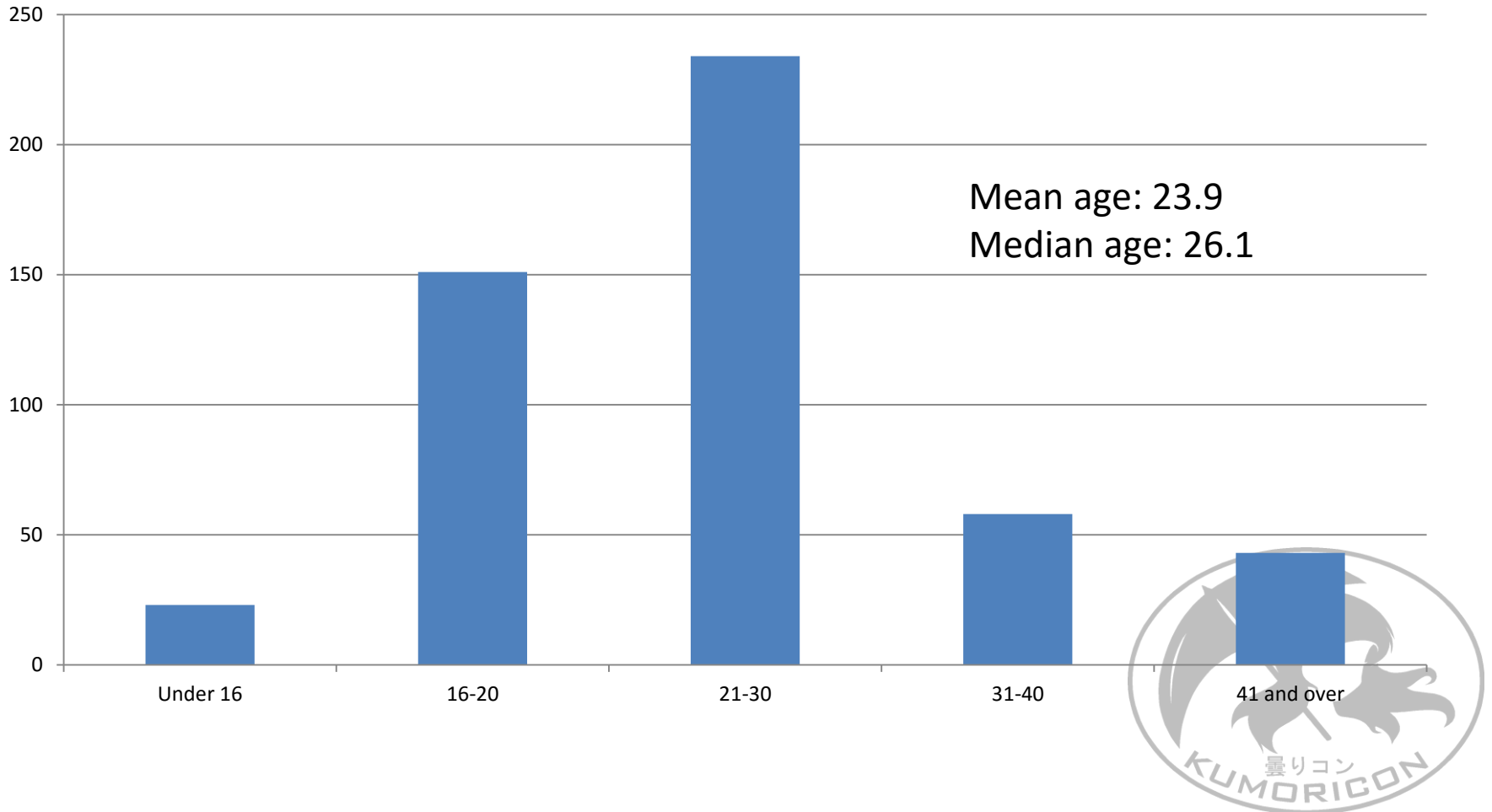

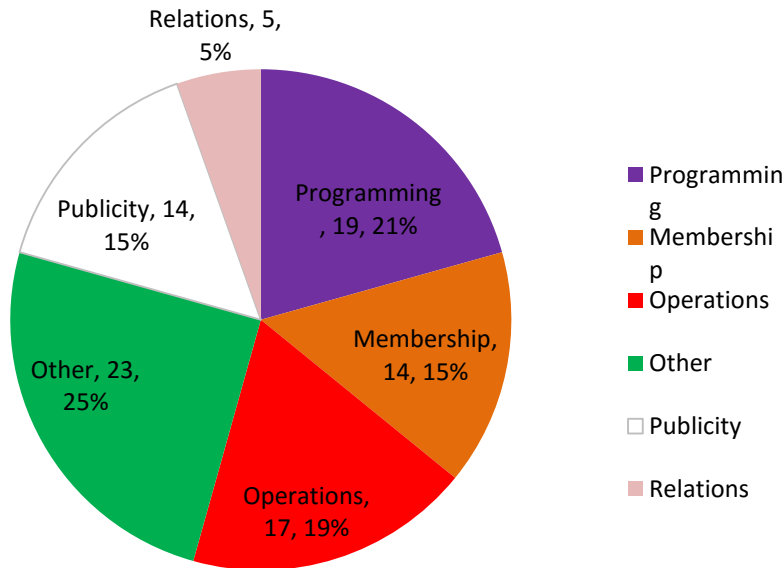
Staff Age Distribution

Staff Age Distribution

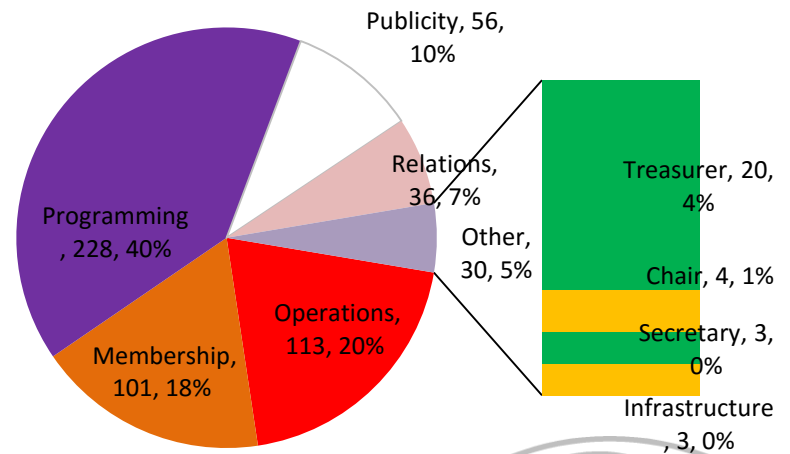

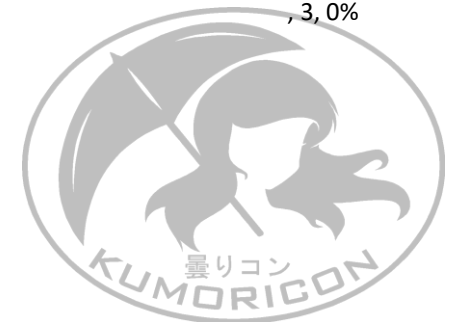
Which department did you consider your primary role?



Actual Distribution Between Departments

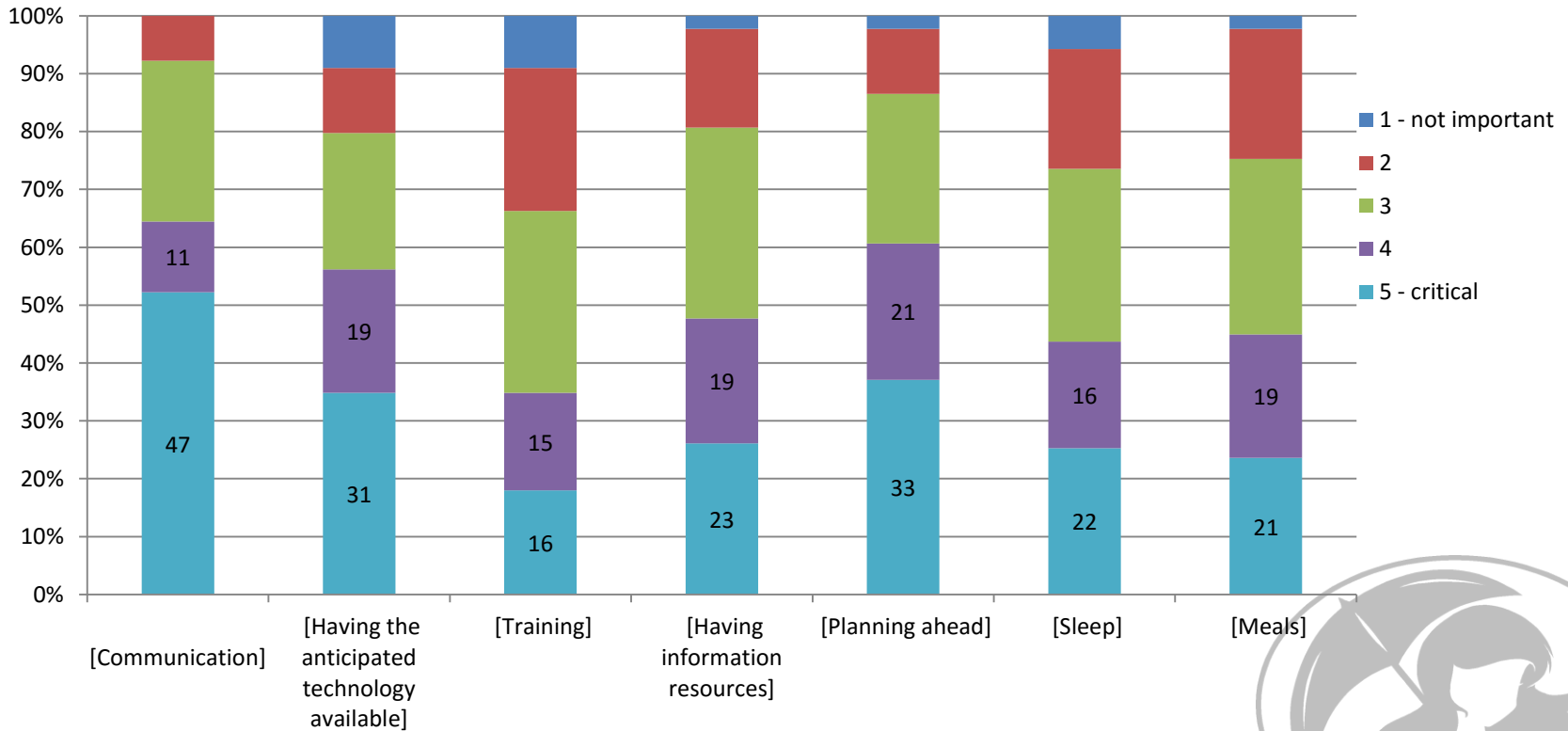


92 staff participated in the Feedback Survey this year, or just under 20% of all staff.



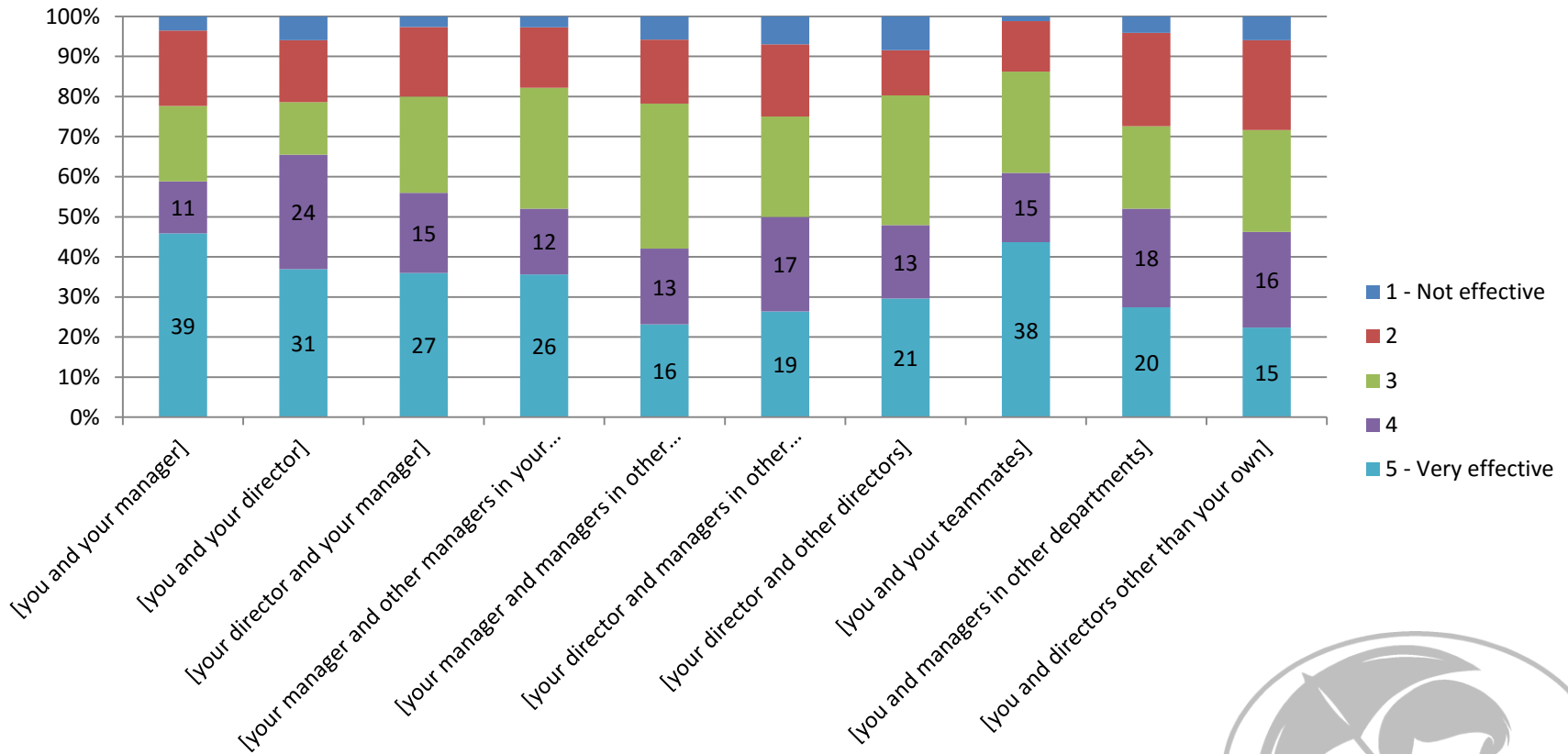
Staff Feedback Survey

How important is each of the following in allowing you to complete your tasks efficiently?



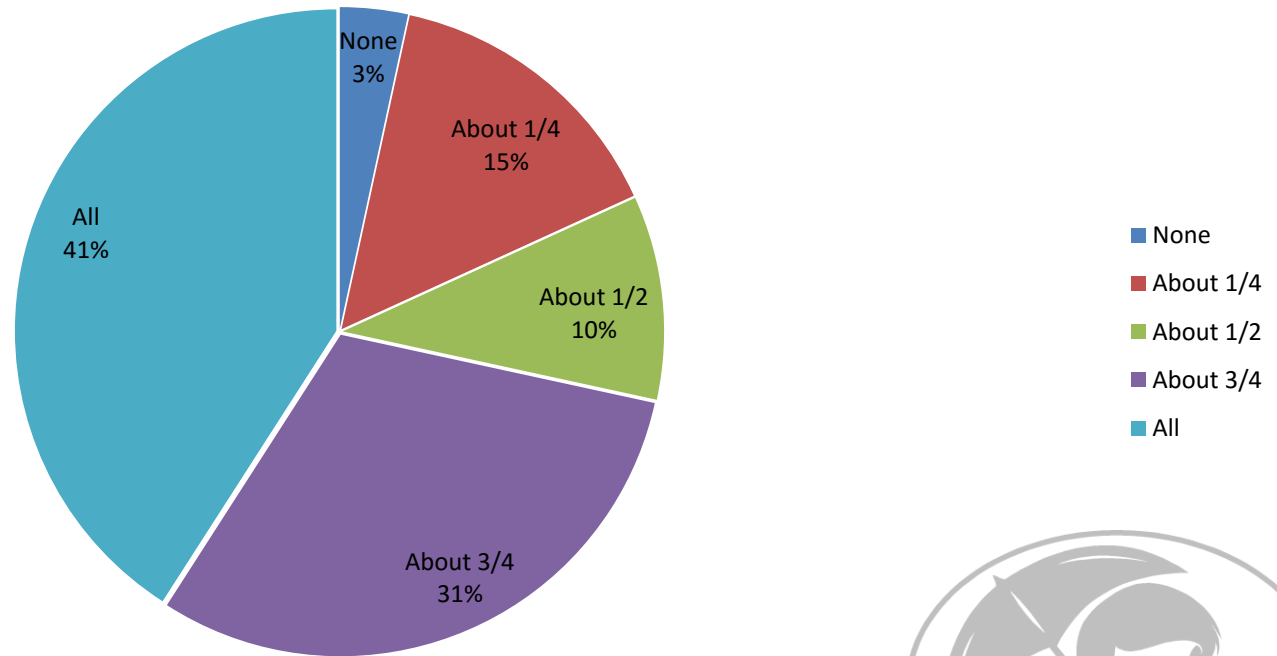

How effective was communication between...



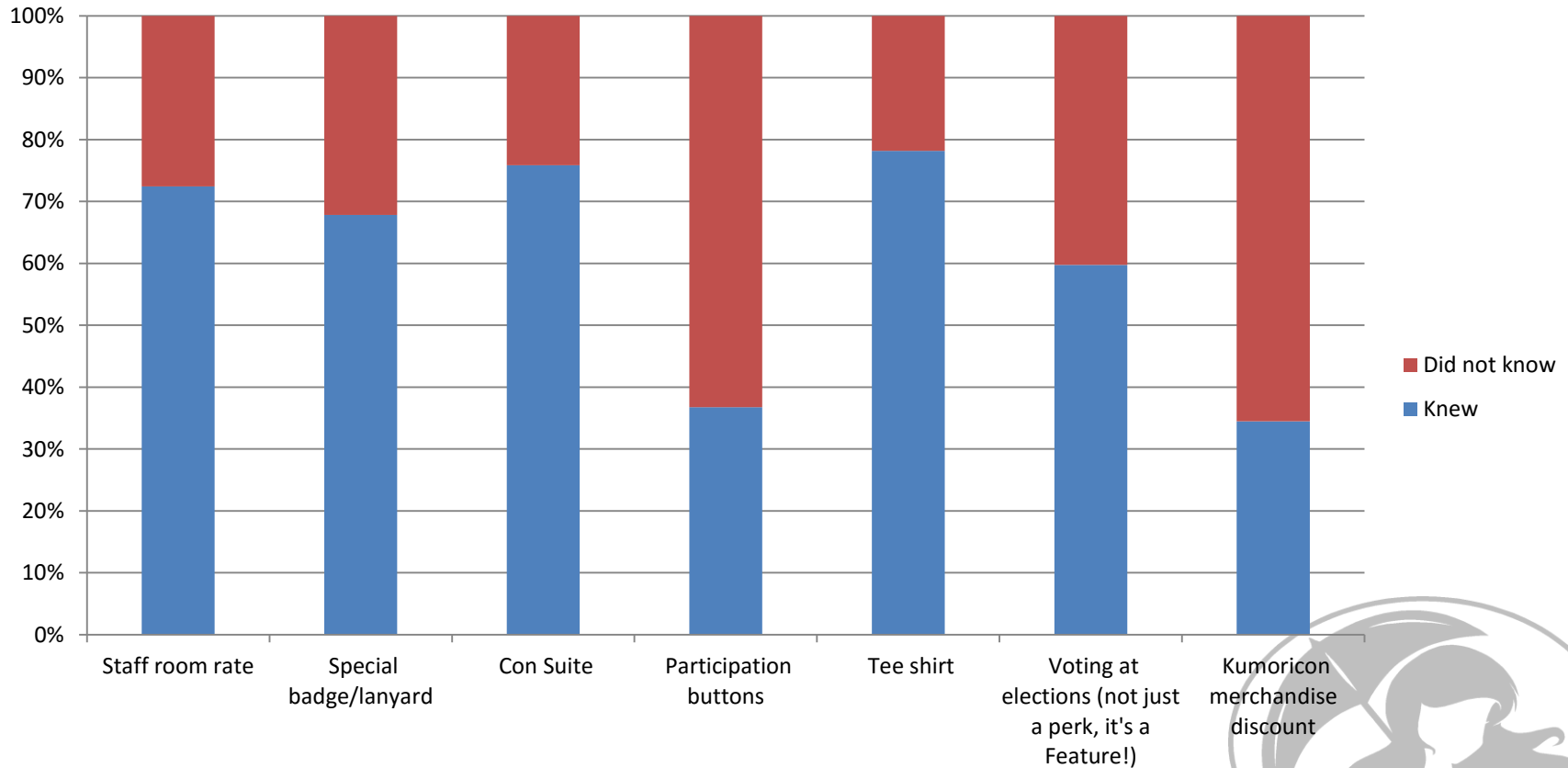

Were you able to participate in the activities you hoped to during Kumoricon?



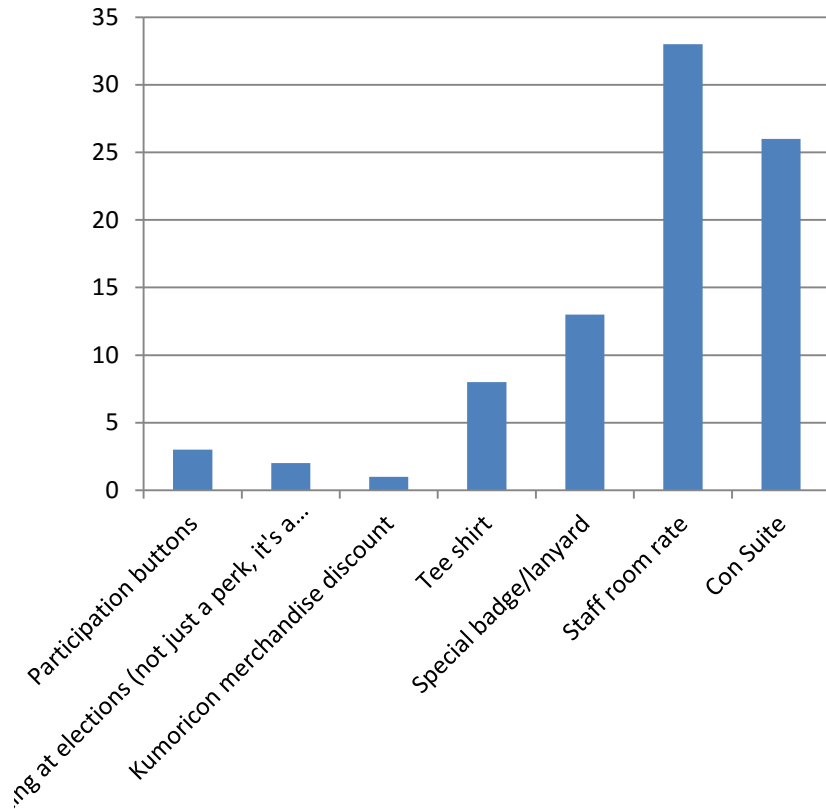

Which of the following staff perks did you know about before con?

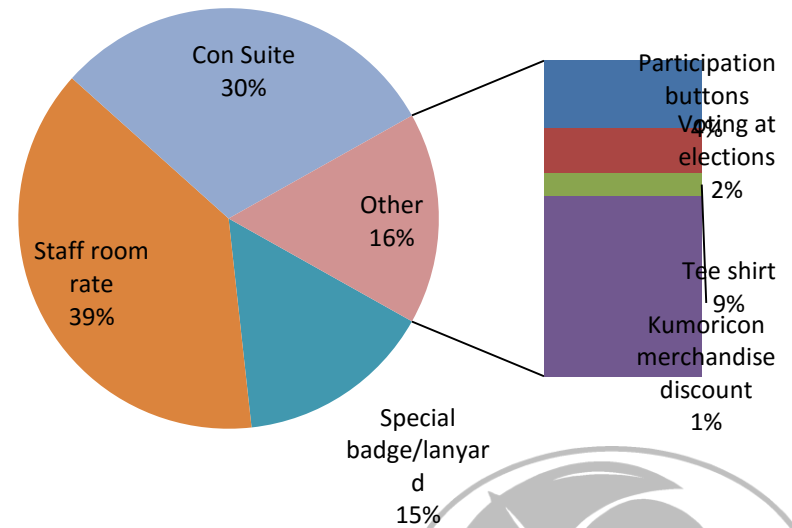

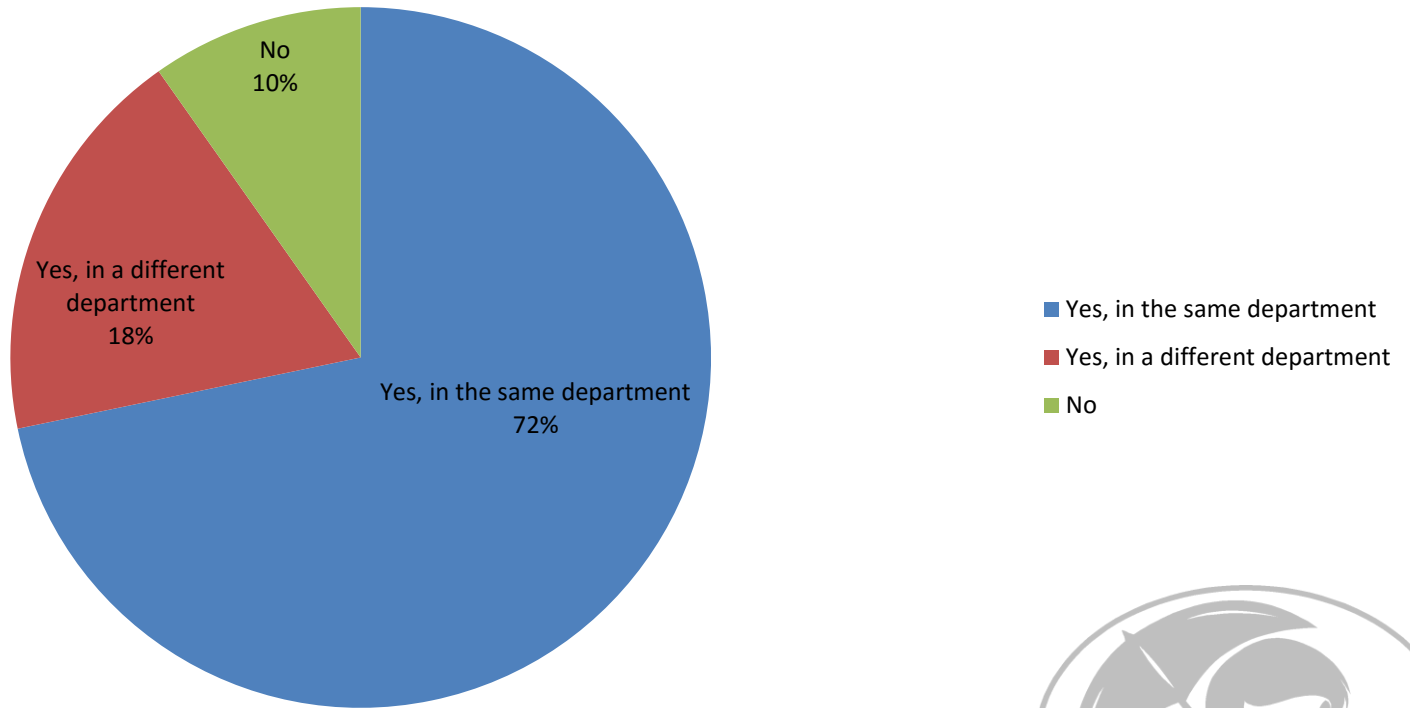

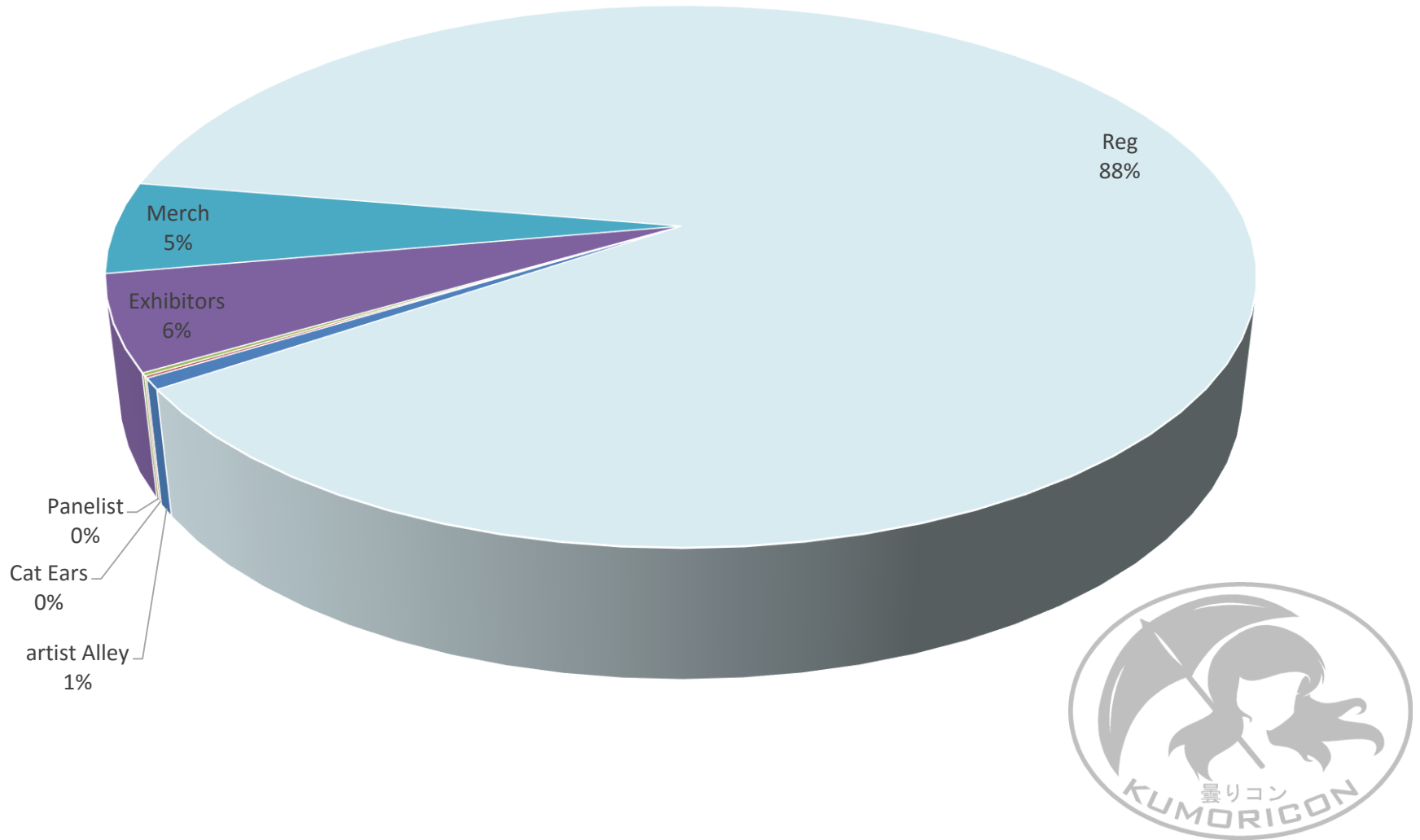


Recap of the Year
