His anime credits include Gamagoori from Kill la Kill; Franky from One Piece; Laxus from Fairy Tail; Keith from Attack on Titan; Motochika from Sengoku Basara; Senji from Deadman Wonderland; Isshin and Kenpachi from Bleach; Germany from Hetalia; Agni from Black Butler; Simon from Durarara!!; Kunzite from Sailor Moon; Sky High from Tiger & Bunny; Luke Valentine from Hellsing and Hellsing: Ultimate; and JP from Redline. Grimmer from Monster and Nekozawa from Ouran High School Host Club don't really fit any of those categories, but they're cool, so they're on the list!

On the video game side of the equation, Patrick's credits include Ragna in the BlazBlue series; Garrosh Hellscream and Arthas Menethil in World of Warcraft; Scorpion in the last few Mortal Kombat games; Artanis in StarCraft II; Kog/Maw, Lucian, and Renekton in League of Legends; Kana Rua in Pillars of Eternity; Basilio in Fire Emblem: Awakening; Samson in Skullgirls; Chopin in Eternal Sonata; Riptide, Hot Head, and Chomp Chest in the Skylanders series; and create-a-character voices in Dragon Ball Xenoverse and The Sims 4.

He must get some secret thrill from watching his books/movies/games backlog grow impossibly long, because Patrick also does script-adaptation and ADR directing. If you've seen shows like Steins;Gate, Romeo x Juliet, Space Dandy, Princess Jellyfish, Deadman Wonderland, Future Diary, or Danganronpa: The Animation, he done writ some of them words—or, in the case of Summer Wars and Wolf Children, all of them words! His directing credits include State of Decay, Fire Emblem: Awakening, Citizens of Earth, Rune Factory 4, Conception 2, Shin Megami Tensei: Devil Survivor 2: Record Breaker (breathe!), Monster, Girls Bravo, and BlazBlue: Alter Memory.

## David Vincent



David Vincent is a professional voice actor and television producer based in Los Angeles, California. He has lent his voice to a variety of anime and video game titles, as well as numerous national commercials for television and radio. David was nominated "Best Voice Actor in an Anime" by the American Anime Awards for his work in GUNxSWORD.

Some of his best known credits include Senketsu in Kill la Kill, Grimmjow Jaegerjaquez and Kouga Kuchiki in Bleach, Li Xingke in Code Geass, Archer/Gilgamesh in Fate/Zero, Assassin in Fate/Stay Night, Van in GUNxSWORD, Seiji in Durarara!!, Arthur August Angel in Blue Exorcist, Jin Kisaragi and Hakumen in the BlazBlue game series, Richard in Tales of Graces F, Raymond Vester in Resident Evil: Revelations, Marshall Law and Forest Law in the Tekken franchise, Shin Kamiya in Tekken: Blood Vengeance, Eliot in Dead Or Alive 5, Keiss in Final Fantasy: The Crystal Bearers, T-Hawk in Super Street Fighter IV, and Richter in Castlevania: The Dracula X Chronicles. Other titles include Halo 4, Soul Calibur V, Spec Ops: The Line, and Alpha Protocol, plus many more new titles to be released this year.

In addition to voice acting, David has also appeared in front of the camera in guest and co-starring roles on primetime television shows NCIS, Criminal Minds, and The Mentalist, among others.

## Erica Mendez

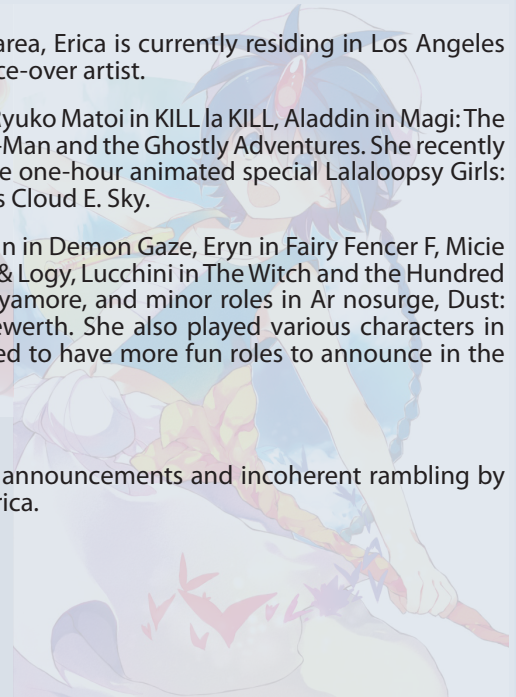


Originally from the Chicagoland area, Erica is currently residing in Los Angeles and working as a professional voice-over artist.

Aside from being an acclaimed cosplayer, LARPer, Slytherin, firebender, half-elf rogue, and self-proclaimed crazy cat mum, Kieran Strange is a quirky, dynamic young artist blending pop sensibilities, edgy guitars, and extremely high-energy live shows into her own personal brand of British pop-rock. Raised on a variety of music genres above her grandmother's pub in a small fishing village in southern England, Kieran left her family behind at the tender age of seventeen to follow her heart and chase her dream of making music, all whilst singing songs about zombies, relationships gone awry, D&D, and video gaming.

As she stands firmly as a voice for the different and discarded, Kieran's die-hard fans, who are disenchanted with the mainstream sense of mind, have coined themselves the #Strangers; their numbers span across the globe, from all four corners of North America out as far as Europe and Asia. Kieran is fiery, verbal, and passionate when it comes to her beliefs, and some of the causes she fights to help support are feminism and equal rights, autism awareness, cancer research, eating disorder and mental health awareness, and anti-bullying both online and off.

"I was really anxious about being open with the world about who I am," says Strange, "especially when it comes to how much I love to game and LARP, and my cosplay. I was scared the music industry wouldn't take me seriously. 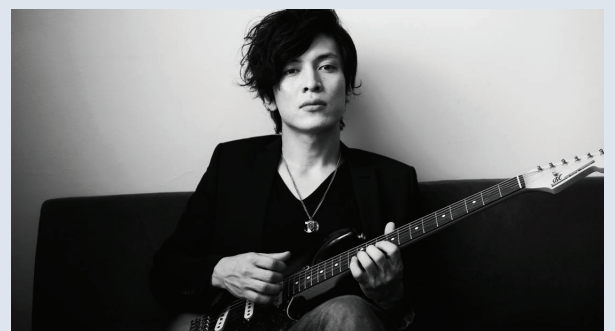

### The Slants



Portland's The Slants are the first and only all-Asian American dance rock band in the world. They offer up catchy dance beats, strong hooks, and a bombastic live show that is "not to be missed" (The Westword). The Willamette Week says "While the band may well be best experienced live, Slants releases always promise a few blistering, note-perfect singles." The music is the perfect combination of 80s driven synth pop with hard-hitting indie, floor-filling beats which fans affectionately dub as "Chinatown Dance Rock".

They've been featured on Conan O'Brien, the BBC, NPR, IFCTV, Huffington Post, MTV, and over 1,500 radio stations, tv shows, magazines, and websites across 82 countries. 18 international tours, including appearances in 46 of 50 US states, have led to headlining showcases at major festivals such as SXSW, MusicfestNW, San Diego Comic-Con, and Dragon Con. The band has also toured/provided support for The Decemberists, Mindless Self Indulgence, Girl Talk, Apl.De.Ap (of Black Eyed Peas), and Shonen Knife. In 2011, The Slants worked with the Department of Defense for a series of shows at US and NATO bases in Eastern Europe, dubbed "Operation Gratitude".

Every one of their last 9 music videos have gone viral, gaining tens of thousands of views within days. Their single, "You Make Me Alive", surpassed 300,000 views in the first few months. Two recent music videos feature martial arts choreography by Sammo Hung (The Matrix, Ip Man, and Enter the Dragon) and international stars Daniel Wu and Shu Qi. They've won "Album of the Year" and "Editor's Choice" from dozens of magazines, including Willamette Week, LA Weekly, Shojo Beat, Village Voice, City Beat, and Rockwired.

Whether rocking music halls, anime conventions, maximum-security prisons, colleges, or army bases, it's clear that The Slants' infectious brand of "so damn good" music will leave you wanting more (MRU Magazine).

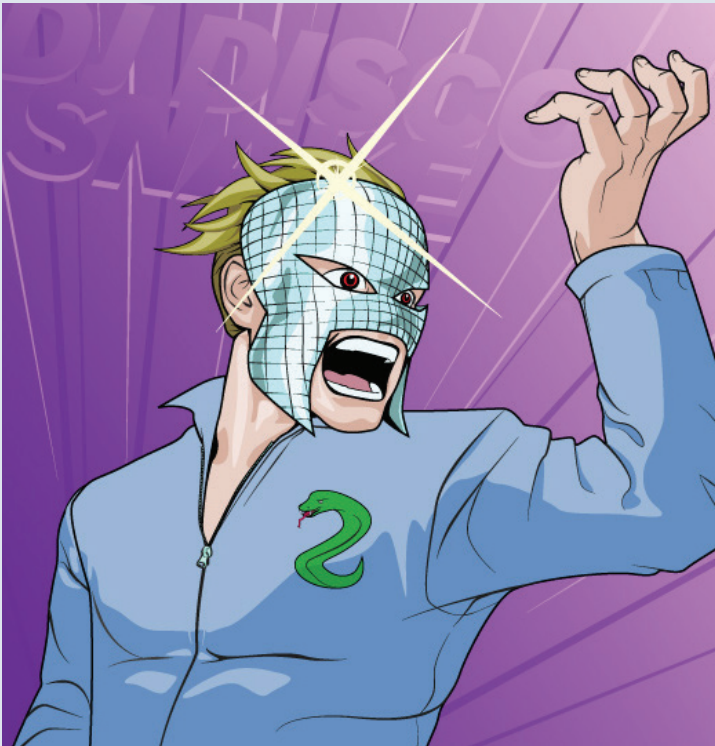

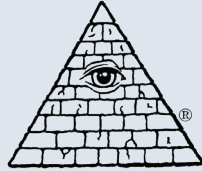

**Place a bid**— An attendee can place a bid on an item by entering their bid and badge number on the bid sheet. All bids must be in whole dollar increments, and must be greater than the minimum bid price set by the artist.

**Winning an item**—The last bid must be completed by 1:00 PM on Sunday.

Please write legibly, and use your full name so we can contact you, if necessary.

In the event of dispute over payment, the art tag will act as a receipt.



## ART PICK UP

**1:00 pm - 4:00 pm** – Highest bidders can claim and purchase the item.

**4:00 pm - 6:00 pm** – Remaining art pieces will be priced at the "Buy it Now" price or the highest bid, whichever is lower. The first person to agree to this price can purchase the item.

If the bidder does not pick up the artwork, they will be noted in our database as a Delinquent Bidder, and may incur the fee of shipping the artist's artwork the following year when registering for Kumoricon.

# KUMORICON CODE OF CONDUCT

## Badges and ID

**ID is required to buy a membership or check in.** Don't forget it! You need ID **no matter what**.

**Badge required:** Your badge is your proof of membership. You must wear it in convention space.

## Age restrictions

**Under age 18? Parent permission and liability release form** required and **curfew** applies.

**Under age 13? Parent must accompany you** (separate paid membership required), **parent permission and liability release form** required, and **curfew** applies.

**Minor curfew:** 12:00 midnight to 6:00 am throughout all convention space.

**To attend an event marked 18+,** you must have a hand stamp. ID will **not** be accepted at the door! Take your **badge and ID** to the Programming Booth to get your stamp (or Programming Office after hours). Some 18+ events are before curfew hours.

No exceptions to curfew or 18+ restrictions!

## For crowded events...

When an event on the schedule says "**pass required**", it means you need to pick up a pass from the Programming Booth earlier in the day. These passes are free, but usually run out quickly. Once all pass-holders in line have entered, we'll open the room to non-pass-holders if there's extra space.

**30-minute line rule:** Please don't line up more than 30 minutes ahead of any event.

## Need assistance?

**Disability assistance:** Please ask a staff member at Registration or in the Operations Office for information on disability accommodations.

**Animals:** ADA service animals are welcome at the convention. Otherwise, animals are not permitted.

**Lost and found:** Lose your badge, phone, or wallet? Find a fellow attendee's lost item? Please pay us a visit in the Operations Office. If we don't have your lost badge, Registration can reprint it for you, but there may be a fee.

**Info booth:** The info booth in the lobby of the Hilton can answer most questions.

**Harassment concerns?** Flag down a nearby staff member, or visit the Operations Office to discuss or report an incident or concern.

## Harassment and offensive behavior

We want Kumoricon to be a safe and comfortable place. Harassment and offensive behavior are prohibited. This includes:

- » Unwanted physical contact
- » Threats
- » Heckling or jeering, either to a person or at an event
- » Staying near another person who has asked you to leave
- » Repeatedly following another person
- » Any form of rude, offensive, or disruptive behavior

## Other banned conduct in convention space

- » Consumption of alcohol (unless presented at an official convention event), drugs (including marijuana), smoking (including e-cigarettes), or intoxication
- » Lewd conduct
- » Unsafe behavior, including real or play fighting
- » Selling or soliciting items or services
- » Distribution of flyers or literature

## Photography

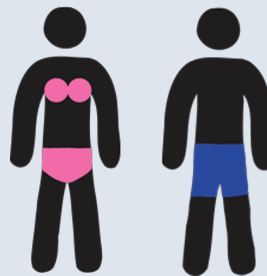
Be polite with your camera and how you conduct your photography or video recording. Photography and video recording are generally permitted, except when:

- » The subject asks you not to or attempts to leave upon seeing the camera;
- » A reasonable person would know the subject would probably not want to be photographed under the circumstances;
- » A panelist or event asks you not to, or a sign prohibits it;
- » In theater rooms, or art in the Art Show or Artist Alley (except with prior artist permission)

## Cosplay, clothing, and coverage

### Costumes or outfits must cover...

**For females:** The groin, complete buttocks, and sides of the breasts

**For males:** Equivalent of a shorts-style swimsuit

Private parts must be fully covered and not visible or simulated.

**Masks or face coverings** may not be worn in hotel lobbies.

**Footwear** must be worn covering the bottom of the feet.

### The following is not allowed in convention space:

- » Signage or clothing containing profanity, explicit or graphic language, slurs, insults, threats, solicitations, or room party advertisements
- » Costumes or props which are vulgar, obscene, graphic, or sexually themed
- » We may limit offensive or disruptive costumes, props, signs, or clothing in our sole discretion





## Prop and weapon safety

### Banned items:

- » Real firearms or ammunition (no exception for concealed carry)
- » Functioning projectile weapons, devices, or toys, including items meant to be thrown
- » Firearms or projectile items that look like they could be functioning from 10 feet away, even if they are non-functioning or are replicas
- » Paddles (all varieties—including “yaoi” or “yuri” paddles)
- » Live steel (sharp enough to cut)
- » Potentially dangerous props which are not part of a bona fide costume
- » Props wide or long enough to inhibit traffic

**Peace-bonding:** Any item or prop that **could** be used as a weapon, could be dangerous, or **appears** to be dangerous (even if it's not), must be peace-bonded. Peace-bonding is an agreement to carry your prop safely, and requires signing an acknowledgement of the requirements of safe carry. A staff member will attach a peace-tie to your item which signals to all staff that your item has been reviewed.

**Where?** Peace-bonding will be conducted near the registration area and in the Operations Office.

### Examples of items requiring peace-bonding:

- » Toy sword made of foam
- » Replica sword made of dull steel
- » Replica firearm

### Examples of items not requiring peace-bonding:

- » Purse
- » Bag
- » Teddy bear

### Prop conduct:

- » Do not brandish or wave around prop weapons
- » Do not point prop firearms at anyone
- » Prop firearms must have a highly visible orange tip
- » Prop firearms and blades must always stay holstered, slung, or sheathed, except while posing for photos

**Special exception for disabled projectile items:** Projectile items or replica firearms are allowed **only** if they are, or have been made, permanently non-functional. “Permanently” means

- » it is not possible to repair or restore the item to functionality.

In most cases this means the item must be filled with glue and all moving parts rendered immobile.

**Purchased items:** If you buy a prop in the Exhibits Hall or Artist Alley, remember to get it peace-bonded, if needed. Also, exhibitors occasionally sell a few things that you can't carry around the con at all, like live steel swords. If you buy one of these, you need to immediately take it off-site or to your hotel room.

## Violations

Any violation of this code of conduct or illegal action may be handled by a warning, temporary convention suspension, permanent membership revocation, or longer ban, in our sole discretion.

Allowable activity at the convention is at our sole discretion. If an authorized staff member tells you to stop doing something, remove an item, or leave an area, then it has the weight of this code of conduct, even if it's not printed in this code of conduct.

## Changes

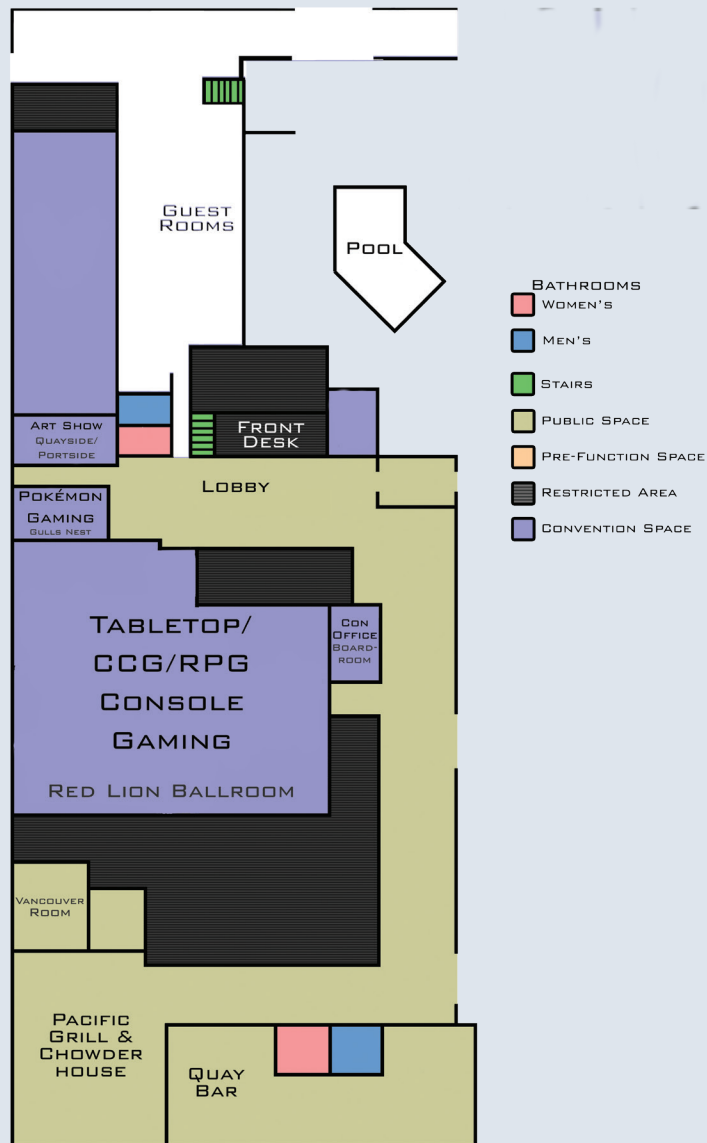
